Botter, Prosecco (Veneto) Pear, apple, and citrus, well-formed, consistent bubbles, and a fruity, dry finish

Duc De Romet, Brut Prestige, Champagne A graceful bubbly, exuding whole-grain bread, mineral, honey and citrus flavors. Well-balanced with a firm structure and a long, mineral- and vanilla-tinged finish.

Goutorbe, Grand Cru, Brut Rose Champagne Violet and ripe black cherry notes with supple structure, offering hints of crème de cassis, spice and candied lemon zest. Very juicy and well-focused.

Gobelsburger, Cistercien Rosé, 2016 (Austria) Seductive aromas include strawberries, perfumed lilacs & violets, lemon peel. The palate offers fresh acidity balanced by round texture; more strawberry leads to peach and tart citrus on the lingering finish. Fresh, medium-bodied and delightful

Il Conte, Pinot Grigio, 2016 (Veneto) Floral and citrus lead to a palate that is fresh, fruity and elegant.

600 Peak, Chardonnay, 2015 (CA) Refreshing and concentrated, with tropical fruit, apples, and citrus.

Jakob Schneider, Riesling, 2015 (Nahe) Dry German Riesling offers up delicious stone fruit, juicy apple and a touch of citrus all wrapped up in amazing acidity.

Cantina Del Taburno, Falanghina Del Sannio, 2015 (Campania) Notes of almond, flowers, lemon, and juicy nectarine

Fiou, "Silex" Sancerre, 2015 (Loire) With fresh and inviting aromas of citrus fruits laced with floral and mineral notes, this wine balances a rich mouthfeel with true liveliness. That sharp acidity makes this classic Sauvignon Blanc from old vines very easy to drink, full of nerve, mineral, and body.

CrossBarn by P.Hobbs, Chardonnay, 2015 (Sonoma) On the palate, the wine is rich and vibrant with flavors that include ripe apple, melon, fig and honey balanced with toasty oak and creamy lees. It has a long, expansive finish that ends with just the right amount of acidity

Black's Station, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2015 (Yolo County, CA) Juicy and fruity on the palate, with hints of raspberries, chocolate, hints of toasty oak. Full bodied, silky tannins, and a long finish.

Mocali, Morellino di Scansano, 2014 (Toscana) 100 % Sangiovese, aromas of crushed berries, spices and hints of vanilla. Medium- to full-bodied, chewy tannins and a clean, fresh finish.

Sean Minor, Pinot Noir, 2014 (Central Coast) Bright cherries, strawberry, violets, and spicy with fine oak notes. Medium-bodied, with good acidity, ripe tannin, and a nice, plush mouthfeel

Graffito, Malbec, 2013 (Mendoza) Dark berries, espresso and earth on the nose. Creamy and seamless in the mouth, showing good concentration and framing acidity to the dark fruit, pepper and oak flavors.

Banshee, "Mordecai", Proprietary Red, 2014 (North Coast, CA) A blend of Cabernet, Syrah, and Red Zinfandel. A blend of both red and black fruit characteristics, espresso roast, licorice & spice.

Aleramici, Il Galampio Rosso, 2015 (Toscana) Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon make up this Super Tuscan wine. Rich, ripe red fruit, jam, and spices, well structured and balanced.

Carpe Diem, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2014 (Napa) Spicy, cherry aromas, with cedar, cigar notes, and hints of vanilla. Full bodied, framed by soft, round tannins.

La Colombina, Brunello di Montalcino, 2012 (Toscana) Bold, plush, chewy, with bright cherry, rum cake, pipe tobacco, and dark espresso bean. Firm, great length, luscious, but yet elegant.
