Quartino / Bottle

- Botter, Prosecco (Veneto)** Pear, apple, and citrus, well-formed, consistent bubbles, and a fruity, dry finish

- Louis Roederer, Brut Premier, Champagne** A graceful bubbly, exuding whole-grain bread, mineral, honey and citrus flavors. Well-balanced with a firm structure and a long, mineral- and vanilla-tinged finish.

Murgo, Brut Rosé, 2013 (Etna, Sicilia) Bright aromas and flavors of red berries, violet & strawberry jelly are long, clean & intense. Lovely sugar-acid balance, with a spicy twist on the long back end. Glass 14.00 / 55.00

Rosato

- Proprieta Sperino, Rosa del Rosa, 2016 (Piemonte)** A blend of 85% Nebbiolo and 15% Vespolina, this pretty wine sings with delicate strawberry and rose petal, and finishes with a bracing and bright minerality and vibrancy.

- Stemmato, Pinot Grigio, 2016 (Veneto)** Floral and citrus lead to a palate that is fresh, fruity and elegant.

- 600 Peak, Chardonnay, 2015 (CA)** Refreshing and concentrated, with tropical fruit, apples, and citrus.

- La Val, Albariño, 2016 (Rias Baixas)** Juicy and focused, offering concentrated Meyer lemon, pear and honeysuckle flavors lifted and given spine by a jolt of juicy acidity. Clings with strong tenacity on the stony finish.

- Jakob Schneider, Riesling, 2015 (Nahe)** Dry German Riesling offers up delicious stone fruit, juicy apple and a touch of citrus all wrapped up in amazing acidity.

- Piero Mancini, Vermentino di Gallura, 2016 (Sardegna)** This refreshing white opens with aromas that recall honeysuckle, citrus and ripe orchard fruit. On the palate, rich flavors, of white peach, yellow apple and pear and balanced with fresh acidity.

- Sylvain Bailly, "La Croix Saint Ursin", Sancerre 2016 (Loire)** With fresh and inviting aromas of citrus fruits laced with floral and mineral notes, this wine balances a rich mouthfeel with true liveliness. That sharp acidity makes this classic Sauvignon Blanc from old vines very easy to drink, full of nerve, mineral, and body.

CrossBarn by P.Hobbs, Chardonnay, 2015 (Sonoma) On the palate, the wine is rich and vibrant with flavors that include ripe apple, melon, fig and honey balanced with toasty oak and creamy lees. It has a long, expansive finish that ends with just the right amount of acidity.

- Fabre Montmayou Barrel Selection, Malbec, 2015 (Patagonia)** Bright, full red. Aromas of raspberry, musky tobacco and mocha. Sweet and nicely vinous, with intense red berry & herbal flavors.

- Mocali, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2015 (Toscana)** On the palate, the dense black fruit tones are soft yet structured, framed by hearty tannins and an underlying current of mouthwatering acidity.

- Scopetone, Sangiovese, 2015 (Toscana)** 100 % Sangiovese Grosso, aromas of crushed berries, spices and hints of vanilla. Medium- to full-bodied, with chewy tannins and a clean, fresh finish.

- Sean Minor, Pinot Noir, 2014 (Central Coast)** Bright cherries, strawberry, violets, and spicy with fine oak notes. Medium-bodied, with good acidity, ripe tannin, and a nice, plush mouthfeel.

- Pio Cesare, Barbera d'Alba, 2015 (Piemonte)** Bright red-ruby. Cassis, black cherry and licorice on the rather medicinal nose. Concentrated and savory; nicely balanced and dry.

- Aleramici, Il Galampio Rosso, 2015 (Toscana)** Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon make up this Super Tuscan wine. Rich, ripe red fruit, jam, and spices, well structured and balanced.

- Carl Roy, "East Side Cuvee", Cabernet Sauvignon, 2014 (Napa)** Spicy, cherry aromas, with cedar, cigar notes, and hints of vanilla. Full bodied, framed by soft, round tannins.

- Aleramici, Brunello di Montalcino, 2011 (Toscana)** Bold, plush, chewy, with bright cherry, rum cake, pipe tobacco, and dark espresso bean. Firm, great length, luscious, but yet elegant.
